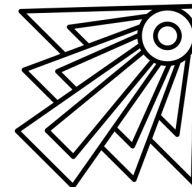

Review the "Gold-to-Silver Rule" on Page 2 before playing!

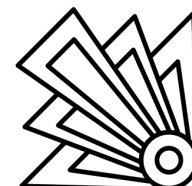

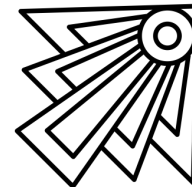
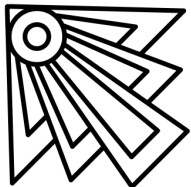
Playing Tokens: None

Objective: Build your tower! Create one stack of cards before it all falls!

How to Play:

- 1) Thoroughly shuffle the Betski™ deck.
- 2) Place **FIVE** cards, face up, in the center of the table. These will be referred to as the "**Center Stacks**".
- 3) Once these Center Stacks have been placed, **draw another card**.
- 4) The **Gold Number** of the card in your hand can then be placed on the **Silver Number of any viable Center Stack** using the Gold-to-Silver Rule. Refer to Page 2 for additional instructions on how to make proper Gold-to-Silver Rule card placements.
- 5) If you draw a card that **CAN** be played on any one of the **Center Stacks**, the placement of the drawn card puts that specific Center Stack into play. **This Stack may now be picked up and placed on as many other viable Center Stacks as possible.** This is done using the top (drawn) card's Gold Number.
 - a. The bottom of the stack will become increasingly larger with each consecutive move, but the initially placed (drawn) card will remain on the top of the stack.
- 6) Once you are no longer able to make any other moves using the **Top Card of the Center Stack**, you must draw another card and repeat this process.
- 7) If you draw a card that **CANNOT** be played, it must then be used to **create a new Center Stack on the table**. Then you must draw another card, repeating the process above.
- 8) To **WIN**, you must form a **single Center Stack** (one stack on the table).
- 9) If the number of **Center Card stacks** ever reaches **SEVEN**, you **LOSE**.
- 10) If all the cards in the deck are drawn and a single Center Stack has not been formed, you **LOSE**.





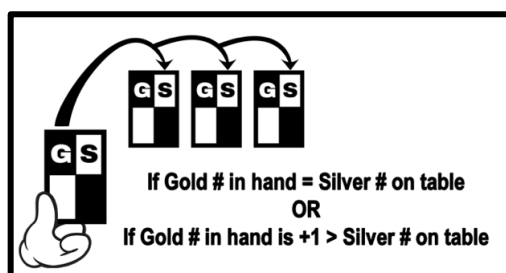
BETSKI CARD BASICS

- There are 49 individual cards in every Betski™ deck.
- Each deck contains every possible combination of “Gold & Silver” numbers 3 through 9.
- Looking at the **top** of each card, players will see a **GOLD NUMBER (Left)** and a **SILVER NUMBER (Right)**.
 - For improved player visibility, each card has an identical top and bottom set of numbers.

GOLD-TO-SILVER RULE:

This rule will be applicable to all Original Betski™ games unless stated otherwise in the individual game instructions.

- **GOLD NUMBERS (left)** are to **ONLY** be used (played) **while being held in the player’s hand**.
- **SILVER NUMBERS (right)** are to **ONLY** be used (played on) once a card has **been placed on the table**.
- **GOLD NUMBERS** that are **EQUAL TO, OR ONE NUMBER HIGHER THAN** the **SILVER NUMBERS** of cards on the table **can be placed on top of the viable card(s) on the table**.
- **Examples of Viable Card placements:**
 - If a **GOLD number 5** is in the player’s hand, they can place the card on top of a **SILVER 5 OR a SILVER 4** card located on the table.
 - If the player is holding a **GOLD number 7**, they can place the card on top of a **SILVER 7 OR a SILVER 6** card located on the table.



- **IMPORTANT:** This system applies to all other numbers **EXCEPT** for a **GOLD 3**, which can be placed on top of a **SILVER 9 OR a SILVER 3**.
 - Players must **NEVER** place a **GOLD 9** on a **SILVER 3**.
- If a player **cannot** make a move using the Gold-to-Silver Rule, follow the instructions of the game you are playing for the next step(s).
